This year has been tough. The pandemic has closed businesses, had managements lay off employees, has created a world filled with fear and anxiety and worst of all, it has taken the lives of thousands of people.

In this holiday season, we can only do so much to lessen the burden of some of our Kababayans. Ms. Nikky Rose Sampang has initiated an Outreach program to the residents of Barangay San Vicente, Bacolor, Pampanga last December 22, 2020. The selected beneficiaries belong to the indigent residents of the barangay.

Furthermore, she has also taken the opportunity to perform a Needs Assessment to discover the current deficiencies of the community, may it be in the area of livelihood, health, wellness etc.

The Preparation

Ms. Nikky has met with the Barangay Captain of San Vicente, Hon. Marieta Sibug and discussed the selection of beneficiaries, the protocols that must be met to ensure the safety of the parties and the donations needed by the residents at that time. The barangay has identified 60 beneficiaries.

Donations in kind and in cash were collected from our benefactors. We have pooled a total of P20,200 and has received supplies of medicines from RSG Pharma Trading. Some of the faculty members have also volunteered in packaging the goods and distributing them to our indigent residents.

Together with the college's SHO Coordinator, Ms. Ann Dominique Manalac has carefully planned the ways in which the project will be successful without compromising the safety of the people volunteering to help.

Per the advice of the Barangay Captain, we have decided to give Noche Buena packages to our beneficiaries. Each bag includes, 1 pack of Spaghetti Noodles, 1 pack of Tomato Sauce, 1 can of corned beef, 1 can of fruit cocktail, 1 box of cheese and 1 can of condensed milk.
